

HOW TO COMPLETE THE INTELLECTUAL PROPERTY RIGHTS (IPR) FORM

Intellectual Property is a product of creative thought that has commercial value, such as artistic works, patents and industrial processes. It is an asset that can be bought, sold, licensed, exchanged or gratuitously given away like any other form of property. As intellectual property is intangible, meaning it cannot be defined or identified by its own physical limits, it must be expressed in some discernable way in order to be protected. The intellectual property owner has the right to prevent unauthorized use or sale of the property.

License Definitions:

Mechanical License – License agreement which provides the license holder the right to reproduce and distribute a copyrighted musical composition, for example a song, to the public. If a musician records a cover version of another musician's song the musician who recorded the cover would need to obtain a mechanical license.

Compulsory Mechanical License – Is similar to a mechanical license, however once the copyright owner of the musical composition authorizes the public distribution of the recording for the first time, anyone else is now allowed to record and distribute that musical composition, under certain conditions, with notice and payment of royalty fees to the copyright holder.

Note: If you create a recording of a performance and use or record copyrighted material you will have the rights to that recording but must still obtain a license agreement to perform or duplicate any of the copyrighted material on your recording.

Master Use License – License agreement which will allow the use of a specific copyrighted recording of a musical composition. If you have used a compilation of music or songs, or you have sampled a portion of another's work you will need to have a master use license.

Synchronization License – License agreement used when a video has been created and includes copyrighted music or other audio. The synchronization license provides permission to use a song or musical composition when synchronizing it to the visual image of the video.

Note: Keep in mind that there are two different copyrights, one for the music (song) itself and one for the recording (master) of the music. The master use license is the permission to use the recording and the synchronization license is the permission to use the music or song in a video.

Distribution License – A distribution license is used when the audio has not been licensed separately as with the synchronization license.
